Aleah James is a dynamic guard with a scorer's touch and true playmaking instincts. Fluent in English, Spanish, and Mandarin Chinese, Aleah brings a global mindset to match her on-court production - a rare combination that stands out both domestically and internationally.

PLAYER BIOGRAPHY

Aleah James is a 5'7" guard out of Brooklyn, New York, whose collegiate career has taken her from Long Island University to the University of Maryland Eastern Shore and now to St. Francis University (PA), where she has emerged as a go-to scoring option and playmaker in her senior season.

After a developmental role at Maryland Eastern Shore in 2024-25 (3.0 ppg, 2.0 rpg, 1.4 apg across 31 games), Aleah broke out in 2025-26 at St. Francis, starting all 27 games and averaging 10.6 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 2.9 assists per game while shooting 39.3% from the field and 33.3% from three. She helped St. Francis reach the MEAC Tournament Semifinals in 2025.

A true trilingual talent - fluent in English, Spanish, and Mandarin Chinese - Aleah offers a unique combination of on-court production and cross-cultural communication that makes her an especially attractive option for programs and clubs with international ambitions.
